- 3. Prefile and Co-sponsor passage of legislation to support the build out and construction of licensed birth centers as their own facility type. Birth Centers are not surgical centers.
- 4. Use your creativity and relationships at the state and federal level to better support our team as we provide care for moms traveling from rural Missouri communities and under-served Kansas City neighborhoods. The Birth Center partnering with Rural Health Clinic or Community Health Center or Critical Access Hospitals could be replicated across Missouri.
